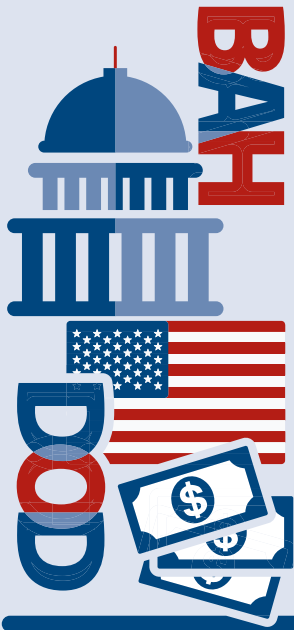

**WHERE DOES YOUR BAH WITH HUNT MILITARY COMMUNITIES GO?**

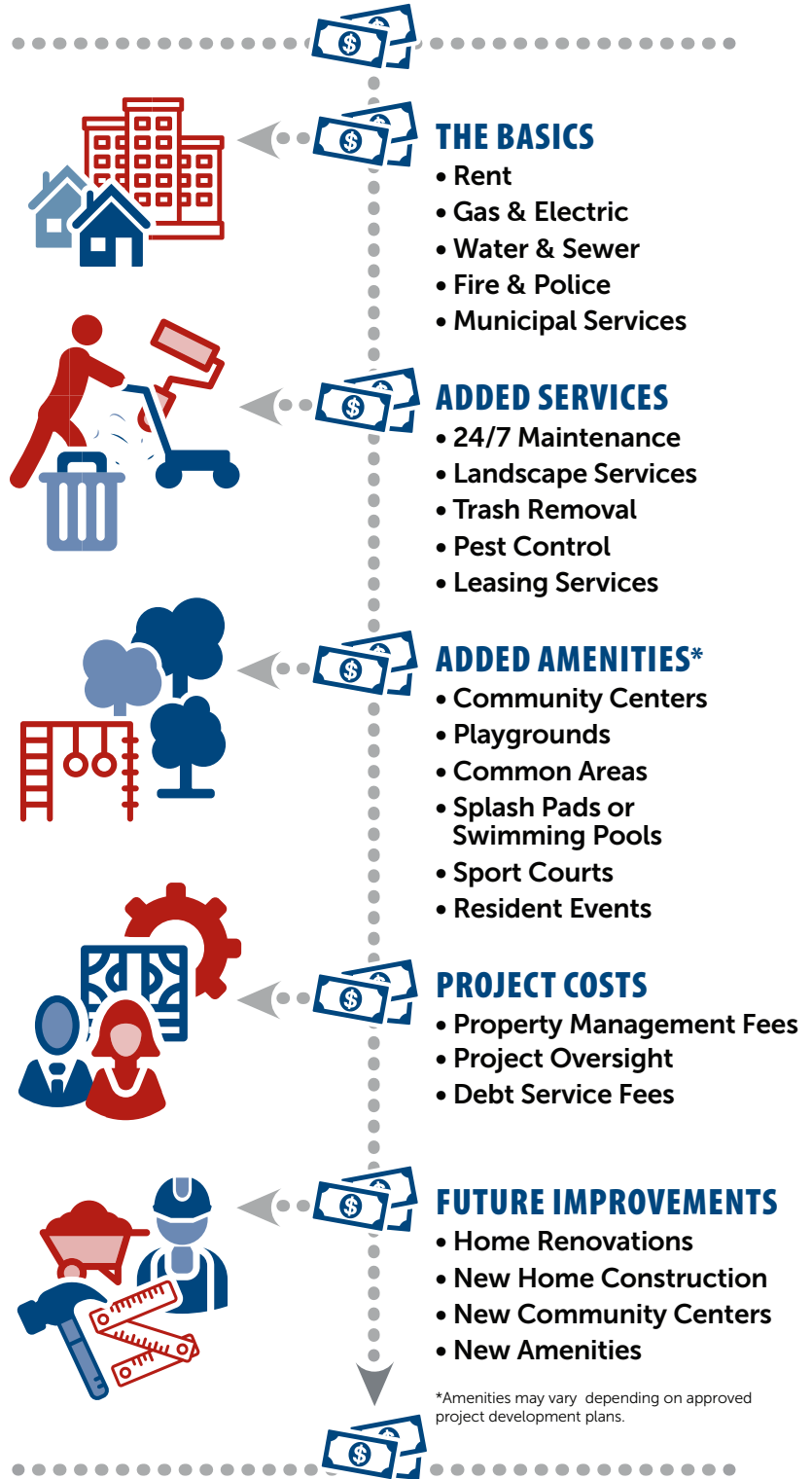


**Your Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) is the stipend the Department of Defense allocates for you to pay for the majority of rent and utilities.**
